There's a pretty good chance you don't know who we are; but if you've had kids in the Butte Falls Elementary School anytime in the last twelve years, we probably have some very nice pictures and thank-you letters from your kids for their school backpacks and supplies, field trips, swim lessons, cross-country and downhill ski lessons, snow board lessons, and outings of various kinds. Those kids often ask, "why do you do this for us?" Our answer is, "Because someone encouraged and helped us at sometime."

We ask now that you pass it on. Help a friend or make a friend by helping them. When they ask, "When can we do this again?" we realize, unless there are adults in their lives who will continue to take them and go with them, they may not be able to go again. Now, with the help and support of the Community School, we are starting a Family Outdoor Adventures Program.

"Family" means any group which includes at least one adult and one youth, who have agreed to participate in an activity together and care responsibly for each other. We plan to offer at least one outing each month throughout the entire year. These will be NON-COMPETITIVE out-of-doors activities, including "how-to" lessons on cross-country skiing, camping, backpacking, rafting, downhill skiing, hiking, and a lot of good old fashioned fun, food, and laughs.

Now, we need your HELP. We need people who will share their knowledge and favorite places and activities with the rest of us. This is as simple as saying, "On this date, I'm going to this place, and would love to have some tag-a-longs." Time and place to meet, and something about what you plan to do. Once we get started I'm sure we will have such a variety of adventures, we'll have a hard time choosing which to go on. We want to DO IT ALL!
