Did you know you can purchase your dog license at city hall? Yes you can and if you do the town keeps 80% of the proceeds. Otherwise if you buy it downtown Jackson County keeps 100%. Now, where would you rather see your money go?

It is burn season once again and you must purchase a burn permit from city hall. The permit cost is only \$2.50 and is good for one year from the purchase date. But before you burn, be sure to call and see if it is a burn day or not. The number to call is 776-7007. If you forget the number just look at your permit, it is written on the front.
