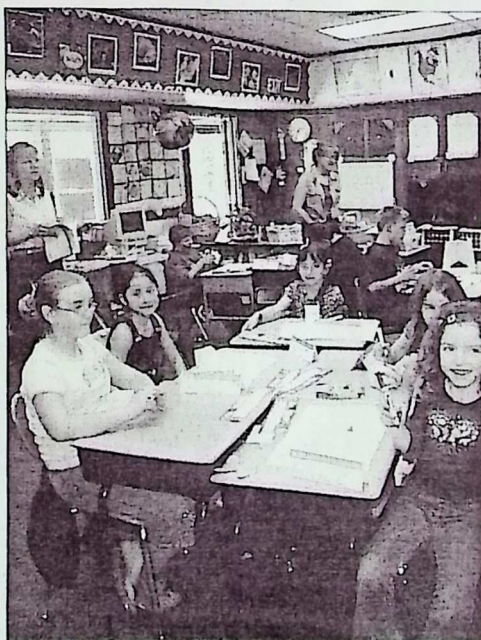
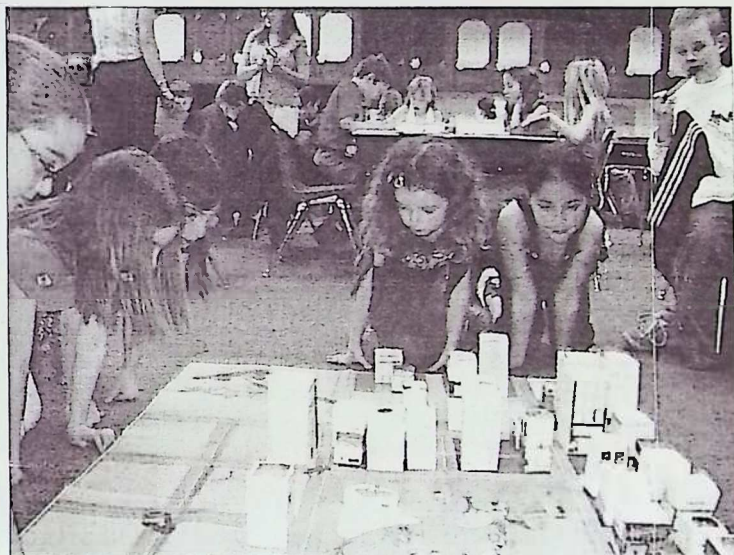
This Is One Partnership That Works!
