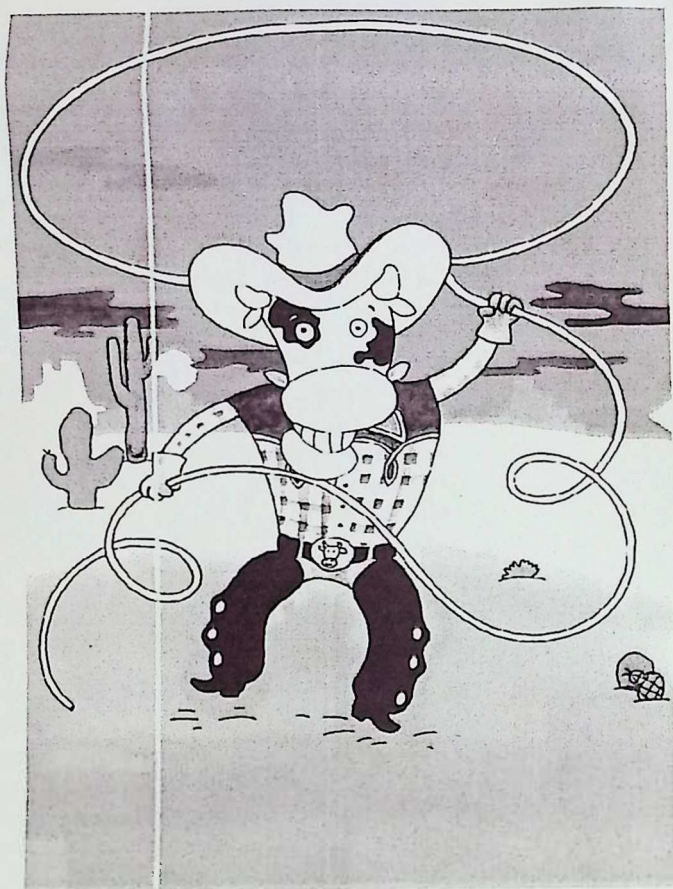

## Wildfire!

The time is here that we must prepare for the event of wildfire. This beautiful area we live in could be turned into a raging forest fire in minutes. But, we can all take steps to reduce the spread of wildfire and help firefighters possibly save your home:

1) Create a 100 foot fuel break around your home, also known as a defensible zone.

2) Clearly have your address posted. This helps get emergency personnel to your house without delay.

3) Plan several escape routes away from your home, by vehicle or by foot. The Oregon Department of Forestry has provided the Butte Falls Volunteer Fire Department with grant money to help our neighbors accomplish this task.
