

Eligibility Guidelines for National School Lunch/Breakfast Program

The federal eligibility guidelines for the National School Lunch/Breakfast Program have changed for the 2003-2004 school year. The income limits are higher than last year. The chart below reflects these changes. If your household income is less than the amounts shown for your household size, your child(ren) may qualify for free or reduced meals. Reduced price meals cost 30¢ for breakfast and 40¢ for lunch.

Application forms can be obtained from any school office manager. Eligibility based on food stamps or Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) will be sent directly to the school electronically. Families with children who qualify for free meals based on this information will receive a notice from the school and will not need to submit any additional paperwork.

Students who qualified last school year will automatically qualify this year for a conditional period of 30 days. At the end of this time, benefits will be terminated unless the proper papers have been filed with the District Office.

If a household member becomes unemployed or if the household size increases, the household should contact the school to see if it is eligible for meal benefits. Applications may be submitted at any time during the school year. Student eligibility status is strictly confidential. USDA and the State of Oregon are equal opportunity providers and employers.

School Visitations

If you wish to come to school and visit a class, please contact the classroom teacher in advance. In some instances, testing or special programs may be taking place at the time you wish to visit. After you have your class visitation cleared, come to the school office to sign in with the office manager and receive your visitor's pass. For the protection of your children, all visitors must check in with the building office manager before they can go to classes. This also applies to visits at lunch or recess.
