

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PURPOSE OF A PROPOSED STREET  
VACATION

The Town Council of the Town of Butte Falls will hold a public hearing on January 18, 2005 beginning at 6:30 P.M. and ending at 7:00 P.M. The public hearing will be held in Butte Falls City Hall located at 431 Broad Street, Butte Falls, Oregon.

The purpose of the hearing is to consider vacating the following described portion of Fee Street in the Plat of the Town of Butte Falls, within the Corporate Limits of the Town of Butte Falls, consistent with the requirements of ORS 271.080 through ORS 271.150.

That portion of Fee Street as depicted on the Plat of the Town of Butte Falls, Oregon, recorded in Volume 1, Page 122 of the plat records of Jackson County, Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

The south 40 feet of Fee Street, adjoining and lying north of Lots 7 and 8, in Block 16, of the Plat of the Town of Butte Falls, Oregon.

A request that the Town Council initiate this vacation was considered on November 21, 2004, and the Council, on its own motion, initiated the request for vacating consistent with ORS 271.130 on December 21, 2004.

The real property affected by this street vacation is described on the current Tax Assessors Map as T35S R2E 10AD, Tax Lot 500, located at 410 Laurel Avenue in the Town of Butte Falls; further, other properties affected are those within 200 feet on either side of the street or portion thereof proposed to be vacated and the land for a like lateral distance on either side of the street for 400 feet along its course beyond the terminus of the part proposed to be vacated, consistent with the provisions of ORS 271.080.

Any owner of real property within the affected area is entitled to comment on this proposed vacation, either by letter to the Town Council or attendance at the public hearing. You must state five (5) specific reasons why you are in favor or opposed to this project, consistent with the statutory requirements, so the Town Council can respond, otherwise you will not be able to appeal any decision that is made. At the public hearing, the decision on the request will be based solely on the requirements of ORS 271.080 through ORS 271.150.
