Next Town Hall Meeting on Protecting Ourselves & Families!

There will be a meeting of all concerned residents of the Butte Falls School District at 6:45 PM on Wednesday, April 27 in the Butte Falls Elementary School Gymnasium. Both C.W. Smith of the Jackson County Board of Commissioners and Mike Winters, the Jackson County Sheriff will attend the meeting. The purposes of the meeting will be:

1. To bring everyone up to date on progress that has already been made since the meeting of March 9th.
2. To ask questions of Mr. Smith and Mr. Winters. PLEASE WRITE ONE OR TWO OF YOUR MOST IMPORTANT QUESTIONS DOWN ON A PIECE OF PAPER AND HAND IT IN WHEN YOU COME IN FOR THE MEETING. WE WILL THEN GET TO THESE QUESTIONS IN AN ORDERLY MANNER AND SAVE A LOT OF TIME AND TROUBLE. THERE WILL BE AT LEAST A LITTLE TIME FOR ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS AFTER WE HAVE DEALT WITH THE WRITTEN QUESTIONS.
3. To discuss the possibility of having people volunteer to drive the main and subsidiary roads within the district during the hours of darkness. This would include nightly travel along the Butte Falls Highway, Cobleigh Road, Crowfoot Road, Derby Road, McNeil Creek Road, Obenchain Road, Prospect Road, Fish Lake Road, Fredenburg Road, and Rancheria Road. We will need to organize radio communications and supplementary funding for fuel in addition to discussing scheduling volunteers in addition to other related things.
4. To schedule volunteers to improve the security at a few target locations where folks among us are the most vulnerable.
5. To discuss ways we might raise the minimal amount of money needed to provide improved security for people who do not have the means to do so for themselves. For example, a steel gate costs \$140.00, motion-activated flood lights are about \$35.00, single bolt dead bolt locks are about \$20.00 each. A watch dog might cost \$100-300.
6. To discuss providing information concerning the possession and safe and legal use of fire arms for personal and home defense. Among the possibilities are classes for those interested only in the legal

aspects of personal and home defense, a series of practical classes in which people become familiar with the effective and safe use and maintenance of fire arms on a firing range, and classes qualifying persons for a concealed firearms carry permit.

7. To discuss ways in which the Security Committee might be given access to confidential information about criminal activity and the location and movements of individuals known to have been engaged in criminal activity.

8. After we have discussed these matters, we will need to reserve adequate time for the question of the development of a rural fire district in our area. Jeff Gorman will lead this discussion.

For those of you who came to the first meeting of March 9th, thanks for coming and lending your support. We need as many folks to come to the April meeting as possible, so plan to be there!
