2+2 is a program offered through Rogue Community College where high school students can earn both high school and college credits at the same time for a small registration fee of \$10 per class.

Butte Falls High School is currently authorized to give credit for the following classes.

MTH95 Intermediate Algebra
CT98 Tool Safety, Use & Maintenance

If a student is registered in a class offering these credits, they will be given a paper for their parents to sign. If the student earns an A or B in the class, the teacher will report it to RCC. RCC will then contact the parents and bill them the \$10.
