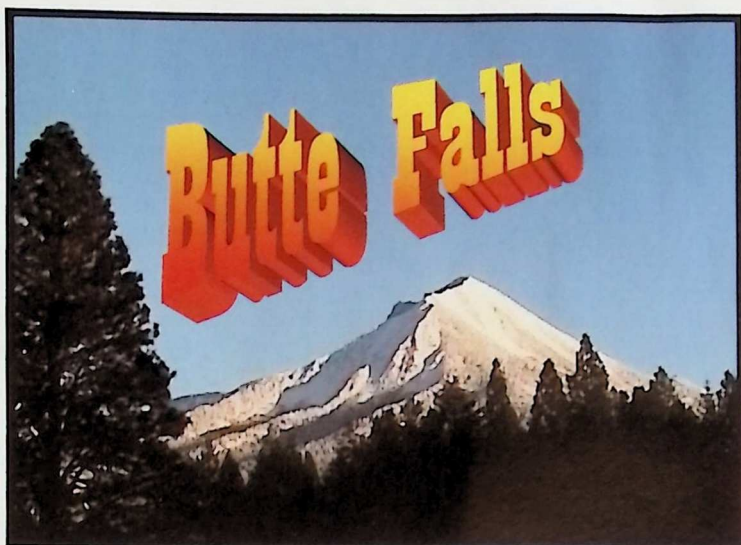




Butte Falls Centennial Celebration & Misery Whip Log Sawing Contest Film & Video 2 Years In The Making
