

Town Information You Need to Know

What we recycle for curb side service:

Carts - (green cans)

1. Corrugated cardboard, **No egg cartons, shoe boxes, cereal boxes or waxed cartons**
2. Newspaper and all that comes in it. **No shredded paper!**
3. Plastics (codes 1-7) with necks smaller than their base. Water bottles, milk jugs, laundry detergent and shampoo bottles. **No butter tubs or cottage cheese containers.**
4. Magazines up to 1/2" thick.
5. Tin cans, aluminum pie plates and aluminum foil. **No scrap metal!**
6. Telephone books.

Carts will be serviced every week except last week of the month.

Recycle Bins - (big blue cans)

1. Glass bottles and jars. Rinsed and lids discarded. **No window panes, cookware or tempered glass.**
2. Used motor oil Up to one (1) gallon plastic containers with screw lids. **Do not use plastic milk jugs.**

Glass and oil will be picked up the last week of the month only.

We will provide weekly service. The carts will be serviced every week except the last pickup day of the month when only glass and oil will be picked up.

Recycle Responsibly - Three Strikes:

It is extremely important our recycle loads are not contaminated by trash. Should trash become mixed into the recycle our transfer facility may reject our entire load. If this happens we will have no alternative but to take it to the landfill for disposal. With this in

mind, should trash be in your cart we will let you know. Any non-recyclable item will be left. If the problem continues your recycle carts will be "repossessed" and your recycling service will be discontinued. **Please understand we do not take Styrofoam, food items, dirty containers, dirty diapers or kitty litter. Abuse will result in termination of this service.**

Butte Falls Recycle Center is open every day at 7:00 AM to 2:00 PM. There are signs posted at the center instructing what is excepted and not excepted. We now have a dumpster for metal items. Remember, citizens outside the city limits are asked to donate a minimum of \$5.00 to help pay for the dumpsters. Of course, anyone wanting to donate is most welcome! Call City Hall at 865-3262 if you have any questions.

Town Meeting Schedule: All meetings are held at City Hall.

1st Tuesday of every month at 7:00 PM - Planning Commission

2nd Tuesday of every month at 6:00 PM - Municipal Court

3rd Tuesday of every month at 7:00 PM - Council Meeting

When special, executive or work sessions are held it is posted at city hall at least 24 hours in advance. All agendas are posted at city hall and bulletin board by the general store at least 24 hours in advance. EOE **The regular council meeting this month will be held on Monday the 19th at 7:00 PM.**
