

Preschool Reopens on September 6th.



Hand To Hand Preschool will reopen for it's 3rd year on September 6th. It will run 3 days a week (Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday) in September and May. Preschool will run 4 days a week October through April when the children are stuck inside. The cost is \$20 a month. All money collected goes to pay for liability insurance and children's supplies. Children **must be 3 years old and potty trained** to enter. Children who turn 3 during the school year may attend as soon as they qualify.

Hand To Hand Preschool is held in a BF Grade School Classroom but is a separate nonprofit entity. It is taught by Jan Nicolaus, a retired teacher with lots of experience. As Mrs. McNeal can tell you, there are many skills that help children

become ready for kindergarten. She is especially interested in the children having basic **self help skills** such as using a tissue to blow noses and putting on outer clothing as well as **social skills** such as following directions, listening to stories in a group, sharing and putting toys away.

Since we are trying to keep monthly costs down so that any child can attend, donations are welcome. Your money will go directly to providing classroom materials for kids.
