

ORDINANCE # 259

An ordinance establishing a curfew for minors under the age of eighteen (18) years and younger for the Town of Butte Falls. This ordinance repeals ordinance # 33 and # 36.

THE TOWN OF BUTTE FALLS HEREBY ESTABLISHES THE FOLLOWING CURFEW:

SECTION 1. CURFEW HOURS.

Winter hours for curfew are weekdays, Sunday through Thursday, 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM.

Friday through Sunday, 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM.

Summer hours for curfew are Sunday through Saturday, 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM.

Summer hours will run concurrently with the Butte Falls School District's summer vacation.

No minor under the age of eighteen (18) shall be in or upon any street, highway, park, alley or other public place within the Town, as stated in above curfew hours, unless accompanied by parents, guardian or other adult having the care and custody of said minor.

SECTION 2. PERMITTING MINOR TO VIOLATE CURFEW PROHIBITED.

No parent, guardian or adult having the care and custody of a minor under the age of eighteen (18) years shall allow such minor to be in or upon any street, highway, park, alley or other public place within the Town, between the hours specified in Section 1, except as otherwise provided.

SECTION 3. VIOLATION PENALTIES.

First Offense: Warning to minor and parents.

Second Offense: Fine of \$25.00

Third Offense: Fine of \$50.00

Any offense there after will be \$50.00 each.

SECTION 4. RESPONSIBILITY OF PENALTY.

It shall be the responsibility of the parent of said minor age twelve (12) and under to pay the fine. It shall be the responsibility of said minor age thirteen (13) and above to pay for the fine.

SECTION 5. The above curfew will not apply to emancipated youths pursuant to ORS #419B.550 to 419B.558.

SECTION 6. The above curfew will be extended ½ hour upon the ending of school functions, youth functions at the Community Hall and private parties supervised by the parent or guardian of the youth giving it.

SECTION 7. DETAINING A MINOR.

Every member of the Butte Falls Police Department while on duty is hereby authorized to detain any such minor who willfully violates the provisions of this ordinance until the parent or guardian of such minor shall take said minor into custody; but such officer shall immediately communicate with the parent or guardian upon taking custody of said minor.
