**Local Christmas Gift Idea**

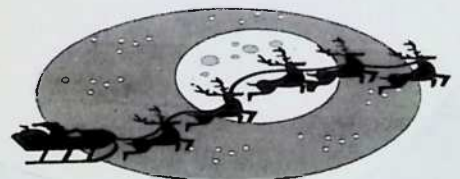
