ORDINANCE #284

An ordinance establishing an interest rate on all delinquent accounts.

WHEREAS the Town Council deems it necessary to establish an interest rate on all delinquent accounts;

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF BUTTE FALLS
DOTH ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

A) The monies owed on past due accounts held by the Town or collection agency will be charged on interest rate not to exceed the rate established by ORS 82.010, Section 1 and Section 2.

B) This ordinance will take effect on February 1, 2006.

Passed and approved on the 21st day of February, 2006 by the Town Council of the Town of Butte Falls, OR.
