ORDINANCE #275

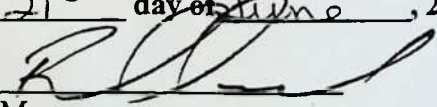
An ordinance to establish rules and regulations for the Recycle Center. As per agreement dated September 5, 1995, the Recycle Center was created adjacent to the Butte Falls Sewer Treatment Facility.

WHEREAS, the Town of Butte Falls has the need to establish rules and regulations for the proper operation of the Recycle Center;

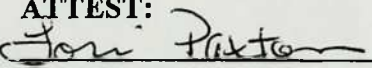
The Town of Butte Falls doth ordain as follows:

- I Recycle Center will be funded and maintained from the Sewer Fund.
- II Operation of the Recycle Center was made up of student volunteers from the Butte Falls School District. Failure of student volunteers to operate premises, the Town has assumed its operation until student volunteers can be reinstated.
- III The following schedule will apply to all fire/school district residents who use the center: \$5.00 for 5 years. Non-residents will pay \$10.00 per drop.
- IV An agreement between the Town and timber entities will be sought to help fund the centers operation. Particularly the emptying of large (30-yd) dump boxes.
- V Hours of operation will coincide with the sewer treatment plant operation. The sewer treatment plant operation is the immediate supervisor of the center.
- VI All monies received will be deposited in the sewer fund and labeled Recycle Center.
- VII Illegal dumping will be enforced by Ordinance #80 with a maximum fine of \$250.00 or community service of not less than 20 hours.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVLED, that the Town of Butte Falls does hereby accept and adopt Ordinance # 275 on this 21st day of June, 2005.
