

Willow Lake...Public Input for Park Master Plan

Jackson County Parks is working with the Community Planning Workshop (CPW) at the University of Oregon to prepare a Park Master Plan for Willow Lake. Public input is an important part of this process. Jackson County Parks will hold a public workshop to obtain comments from all city residents on what they envision for improvements to the Willow Lake recreation area. The workshop will be on September 20, 2006 at 6:00 PM at the Butte Falls Community Hall.

Jackson County Parks has been exploring ideas for Willow Lake related to improving circulation and access; protecting water quality; enhancing financial viability; and innovative campground design. The Willow Lake Master Plan will provide detail on how county park facilities will be developed in the future. This public meeting on the 20th will be an excellent opportunity to share ideas and provide input on the master planning process.

The consultants working with Jackson County Parks on this project are affiliated with the University of Oregon Planning Workshop Program. The selection of this group was made because it provides the County with the expertise of the professional land use and landscape architectural staff at the University as well as gives students in these fields an opportunity to have hands on experience working with a community to plan for parks.
