Due to problems at the falls area the property owner has requested a gate be place on the Falls Road to be open during daylight hours only. Person or persons violating this closure will be cited.

The property owner also has requested that the individuals, both past and present, that have dumped items other than yard clippings on the brush pile west of town be issued a citation. Anyone dumping garbage will be cited to the town court.

On a lighter note we are acquiring a potential new customer for our bulk water sales. We have installed our by pass line to deliver spring water directly to our bulk plant. Thanks to the Butte Falls Community Development Corporation for the money you had left to help get this project done.

We have also passed our annual water test (\$1,500) with flying colors. We are currently working on our storm drains all over town to control flooding problems this winter, 'we hope'.

We hope that you like the new street work on Cedar and Fee. The next project is for Oak and Fee Streets. A big thanks to ODOT for our street grant.

The cemetery is starting to take shape. We've painted the buildings, fixed a water leak and are getting new markers for the older side of the cemetery to replace the ones you can't read. An Oregon Historic Cemetery Grant is paying for the markers and Rick Carle will create a new sign at the entrance. Thank you to Karen Davis, Cherin Ingraham and John Tuney for the good work that you have done at the cemetery.

We are considering a flat rate for our water bill. The monthly bill for water and sewer would be \$61.50. This would raise the monthly allowable usage from 1,000 gallons to 20,000 gallons. Please comment on this idea and look at how much your monthly bill is.
