The Town of Butte Falls is now accepting applications for the following position:

Position: Seasonal, part-time assistant Level III in the Public Works Water/Street Department. Employment period is from April 1st through November 1st.

Pay Rate: 1st year - minimum wage

2nd year - minimum wage + \$.50

3rd year - minimum wage + \$1.00, if received certification in water/sewer.

Hours: 16 per week

Requirements: applicant must have a high school diploma or equivalent, possess basic math skills, must possess a valid Oregon Driver's License, pass a background check, physical exam, and drug-screening test, be of good moral character with no felony convictions. Experience in heavy equipment operation is a plus. Must be physically capable of handling the day to day responsibilities in the water/street department.

Duties: Assist in maintaining town water lines. Clean and maintain reservoirs. Maintain city streets. Mow City Park, empty trash containers; maintain grounds at sewage treatment plant, etc.
