Regarding your ambulance membership fee

For quite a few years now, your Angels of Mercy have been donating an annual fee to Mercy Flights, Inc. to pay for the Butte Falls area Mercy Flights Membership. This means that for every ground or air (helicopter or fixed wing airplane) transport from the BF area (our school district boundary) you have been covered as a member-no charge for the transport if you have insurance. If you don't have insurance, Mercy Flights, Inc. will cover one half of the bill!

Mercy Flights, Inc. recently notified us that starting 2008, everyone in our area would still be covered by our Angels of Mercy donation, but each household would need to pay an additional fee of \$30 if they want to add air transport. That is still an awesome deal for our area. The cost of each flight is very expensive and to have this option is a blessing.

What this letter is for, is to let you know of yet another blessing. Our Angels of Mercy have done it again! They have covered this \$30 fee for air transport! Every household in the Butte Falls area is covered by Mercy Flights, Inc. air and ground membership!

The Forest Service to sell two residential homes in Butte Falls

Former employee housing in Butte Falls that is no longer needed by the Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest will soon be disposed of through special legislation.

Two single family residential homes will be disposed of as two separate parcels under the "Forest Service Facility Realignment and Enhancement Act of 2005". This Act allows the agency to sell administrative facilities it no longer needs and to retain the proceeds to reinvest in facilities for deferred maintenance and improvements.

The property will be sold for no less than the market value to the apparent high bidder through the General Service Administration (GSA) on line auction procedures.

Each property will be auctioned concurrently and separately on the General Services Administration Real Property Disposal website at www.auctionrp.com. Look for more information in November 2007 as the agency releases an "Invitation for Bids" package to the public.

Information will also be listed on the auction website and will give potential bidders an opportunity to become familiar with the properties, download the "Invitation For Bidders" package and register for bidding.
