We received a generous grant from Cow Creek Umpqua Indian Foundation of \$7,500.00 to help with the cost of our youth Programs. With this grant we can continue to offer camps, field trips and classes for our youth. We will be able to have a safe and fun place for kids in our town to go because of this funding. More great news is, because of our hard work and our devotion to serving our town, we, Butte Falls Community School Partnership, have succeeded in further steps of providing a building to offer all of our classes, events and programs. Because of a generous gift from a donor, who wishes to stay anonymous, we now own the old Forest Service building. We feel honored to receive such a huge donation and are very excited to start serving our community of Butte Falls through this new center. In this building we have already started Self-Defense/Martial arts classes on Mondays and Thursdays. We plan on expanding our exercise room with exercise equipment and more classes. We are currently moving the Preschool from the elementary school into to our new building, which will free up the class room for the elementary staff and students. We look forward to having the preschool in the building with us and plan on offering classes for the parents of the preschool students during class time. We are currently moving in our new food pantry because of a valued partnership through Access Food Share. We are working on completing our fun and safe Youth Center where there will be homework help, computer/internet access, cooking classes, fun game room, and so much more. We will be offering health services for our community also. We look forward to having a produce sale before the end of summer for all of you gardeners. These are just a few of the many wonderful opportunities and services we will be offering out of this new center.

Of course all of these things are not possible with out the dedicated volunteers in our town and also the donations given from local business owners and community members. We have also had a lot of help from outside of Butte Falls as well. There has been countless amount of hours given by a group of students and adults from Trail Christian Fellowship. They have generously given their time, hard work, money and support in helping complete this center. They said, as we all know, "This is the best thing that has happened to Butte Falls in a very long time." We are going to celebrate the opening of our new building, "The Landing", later in the summer so we will keep you all informed as everyone in Butte Falls will be invited for the ribbon cutting ceremony."
