

ORDINANCE #335

An Ordinance Declaring the Town of Butte Falls as a Dispensary Free Zone for the Purpose of Selling Marijuana or its Paraphernalia and to Define Provisions For OMMP Card Holders or Growers.

WHEREAS O.R.S. 475.300 approved the use of marijuana for medical purposes in the State of Oregon, the Town of Butte Falls doth ordain as follows:

1. The Town of Butte Falls will not issue a license to any business whose purpose is to conduct business that is in violation of any federal law.
2. A patient who holds a medical marijuana card for a qualifying health condition must be registered with the OMMP, which is run by the Oregon Health Authority, and must be diagnosed by an Oregon licensed MD or DO.
3. Patients must carry their OMMP ID cards when possessing marijuana away from their home. Patients from out of state will follow the same rules and regulations of OMMP and the Oregon Health Authority.
4. Patients must not consume or cultivate marijuana in public view.
5. Patients must obey laws set forth in O.R.S. 475.300 through 475.346.
6. In keeping with the provisions set forth by the Oregon Health Authority, no marijuana dispensary may open or operate within 1,000 feet of a primary or secondary school or within the boundaries of the platted portion of the Town of Butte Falls.

The Town Council does hereby approve and adopt Ordinance #335 on this 18th day of February 2014.
