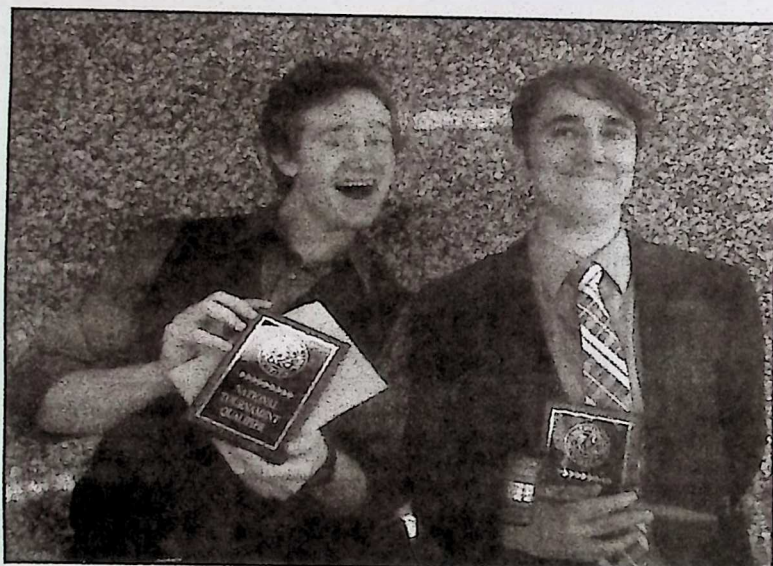




Adam Carlisle and Luke Kuykendall will be attending nationals in Kansas in June
