

The Value of a School-Based Health Center

Did you know that YOUR Community Health Center is also a state-certified School-Based Health Center (SBHC)? That means that students have access to medical care, without having to miss an entire day of school. Not only can students receive care for acute illnesses such as colds or flu, but they can also receive preventive care such as well-child checkups and immunizations. There is a Licensed Professional Counselor on staff as well, available to assist students with emotional and/or behavioral issues while maintaining student's privacy under Federal (HIPAA) laws.



- ◆ SBHCs decrease absences, tardiness and discipline or behavior problems.
- ◆ Students who use SBHCs have an increase in GPA and overall school attendance.
- ◆ Adolescents have the highest risk of mental health or behavioral needs, and they are **at least** 10 times more likely to use mental health services if they are available at a SBHC.

Butte Falls SBHC serves patients age 5-18, regardless of their insurance status or ability to pay.
