

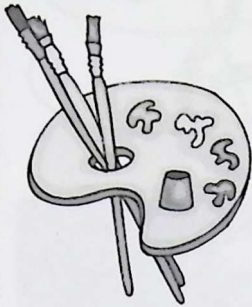

The Town of Butte Falls has hired a Code Enforcement Officer. Sarah Lunt was raised in a small community in the White Mountains of Northern Arizona. She served in the United States Air Force, worked as an Adult and Juvenile Probation Officer, and a Correctional Officer for the Alaska Department of Corrections. Sarah enjoys the outdoors and is looking forward to exploring Butte Falls and the surrounding area.

The focus of the Code Enforcement at this time are Public Nuisance (accumulated/unregistered vehicles, debris, trash, etc), Sitting Recreational Vehicle(s), Dogs at Large, Burning Regulations and Fire Prevention Regulations, and Slow Moving Vehicle(s)/ATV's. Community pride starts on a small scale and expands until the entire town is affected. Ideally as a community these issues can be self corrected. Please remember change starts with us individually. If your yard is cleaned up and squared away, please talk with your neighbor and offer assistance. If you need assistance, contact the Community Partnership for Revitalization (CPR) committee, any high school student in need of community service hours, or Ms. Lunt at City Hall.
