BFCS has identified several excellent candidates for other consultant positions and work continues to formalize those agreements.

We have also hired James Beaver to provide a marketing and outreach plan. The plan will include:

- marketing to increase student enrollment
- engage community members and encourage community partnerships that will provide support to students academically and provide guidance in post-secondary transitions.,
- outline strategies to build a volunteer and mentorship database
- identify graphic design and development needs of Butte Falls Charter School
