



Community Partnership for Revitalization March Meeting Notes

Approximately 20 people attended the CPR Meeting held 7:00pm, Thursday, March 12 at the Community Hall. Meetings are the second Thursday of each month at the time and place designated above. All are welcome.

Ideas for use of Plum Creek Lands.

A general brainstorming session was held to compile ideas on how the town might use Plum Creek Lands. The ideas will be incorporated into a Master Plan to be submitted to Plum Creek. Many ideas focused on using the Falls area for education, recreation and historic interpretation. Another focus was right-a-ways for the use of an historic railroad and several destinations for rails-to-trails hiking and biking. Also it was suggested that the land near the sewage treatment plant could be utilized as a storage facility.

Code Enforcement.

Sarah thanked everyone for their assistance on the alley cleanup. Clean-up days will be held the 1st Saturday of each month from 8:00-12:00. The April clean up will be held on Saturday, April 4th in the town park.

Butte Falls Discovery Loop.

We reviewed the sites on the old brochure. We thought that the following need to be deleted: Logging Arch (not sure if access is possible or if it still exists), Cat Hill Burn, Fish Hatchery (there was not agreement about the Fish Hatchery. We will check with the school and see if they want visitors). None of us knew if the Giant Sugar Pine was still there so that may or may not be on the list.

This is our tentative primary site list: Cemetery, the falls, the town, Willow Lake, Whiskey Springs, Medco Ponds, Scenic Mt. McLoughlin views (Blue Ridge), Lower S. Fork Trail, Imanaha Guard Station, S. Fork Bridge, Lodge Pole Kiosk, Ice Cave and old CCC Camp and the giant sugar pine-- if it exists. By the end of March, please review this list and let me know if you have any deletions or additions.

This is a tentative list of secondary list of sites that we might mention as "good to check out on the way" to the primary sites: Indian massacre place on Rancheria, Little Tokyo Falls, Mt. Pitt School location, Camp #4 and RR town (this side of Lodgepole on rt and lft of road), Lodgepole Guard Station (not really accessible so maybe off the list and just included as a place to stay?), Military Road from Whiskey Springs to CCC camp, maybe the rifle range.

By the end of March, please let me know what you think about the list of secondary sites. Are there any you would delete or add?
