

Butte Falls - Prospect Baseball and Softball Co-Ops

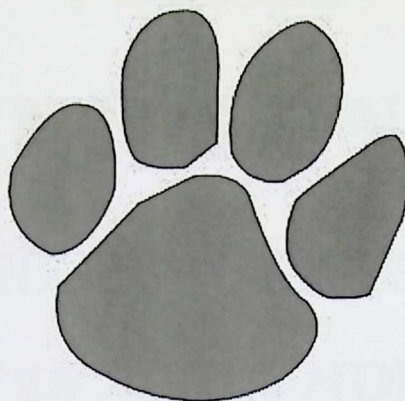
