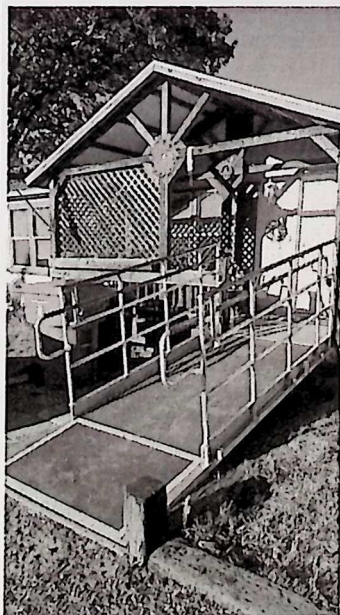
MAKING A DIFFERENCE
