General Summary of Duties: The preschool teacher is responsible for providing a safe and developmentally appropriate preschool program for children 3-5 years of age that nurtures children and prepares them for school success. Implement aspects of the GROWING UP WILD PROGRAM as children prepare to enter the Butte Falls Natural Resource based Charter School. Incorporate the SEARCH INSTITUTE 40 Developmental Assets for Early Childhood as students combine play, hands on projects and developmentally appropriate academic, social/emotional, art and movement instruction that ensures children are intellectually, socially / emotionally supported and engaged. Promote parental engagement as the child's primary teacher by modeling and teaching parents skills needed to foster the early childhood assets that help children grow up healthy, caring, and responsible.

Bachelor degree in Early Childhood Education preferred; and
Current first aid/CPR certification

EXPERIENCE: Minimum two years experience working with preschool aged children.
