Experience

Currently, I serve on the Town Council where I am Council President. I chair the Safety Committee dealing with emergency planning, the safety of playgrounds, town facilities and working conditions of our employees.

I am on the Board of The Landing. We support a pre-school, after school program, summer nature camp, as well as community activities for adults like bingo and 55+ pot lucks.

For 5 years I served in the Active Club helping to put on the Fourth of July and Christmas celebrations. I also serve on the Friends of the Library committee.

To help boost the economy of Butte Falls, I founded the Community Partnership for Revitalization (CPR).
