 - FEBRUARY - Ten years after becoming America's first man in space, Alan Shepard takes a break on a return trip, this time as commander of Apollo 14, to hit a couple of golf balls on the Moon February 6, 1971. His makeshift club—a 6-iron head attached to a sample collector handle—"was very clumsy with our suits" he later recalls, but with the Moon's lower gravitational force, the ball travels about 200 yards instead of the 30 it might have on Earth. The Apollo 14 astronauts spend nine hours exploring the lunar surface and collect 100 pounds of rocks before returning home February 9.
