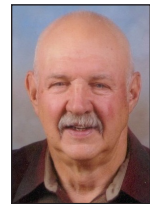

Bob was beloved by many and will be missed.

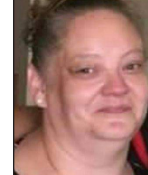
