Mount Hood National Forest Integrated Weed Management Program 2021: An integrated weed management program that includes the use of herbicides, hand pulling, mechanical methods, and biological controls is to be implemented on the Mt. Hood National Forest (Clackamas River, ZigZag, Barlow, and Hood River Ranger Districts) beginning in May as sites become snow-free, and will continue through summer and fall, as conditions permit. All restrictions and regulations regarding the use of herbicides will be followed as stated on the herbicide label and in the Record of Decision and Final Environmental Impact Statement for Site-Specific Invasive Plant Treatments for Mt. Hood National Forest and Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area in Oregon, including Forest Plan Amendment #16 (March 2008). Invasive species scheduled for treatment include knotweed, hawkweed, knapweed, herb Robert, shining geranium, houndstongue, toadflax, false brome, sulphur cinquefoil, Himalayan blackberry, Scotch broom, and English ivy. Herbicides will be applied by state-licensed personnel directly to target weeds using ground-based equipment or backpack sprayers. Application dates are weather-dependent. Monitoring and site restoration will be done as prescribed by the local forest official.


