THE W. P. LINE

San Francisco, Feb. 7.—Permission to issue bonds in the sum \$55,000,000, bearing interest at five per cent and maturing in 20 years, was asked of the state railroad commission today by the Southern Pacific company.

Of this amount \$29,000,000 are for refunding short term notes already issued and the remainder for betterment and additions. Inasmuch as \$21,500,000 of the original issue was also for betterment and additions, the total proposed expenditure for this purpose will be \$47,500,000.

Among various items of improvement which the company stipulates as specific reasons for asking this permission appear the following:

Complete construction of Willamette Pacific railway, \$2,989,075; Colusa and Hamilton railroad, \$643,854; Fernly and Lassen railroad, \$2,065,840; Willamette Valley Electric lines, \$1,425,478; Sunset lines construction, \$709-366. Another item for construction of the Sunset lines amounts to \$1,512,676.

Without specifying where they are to be located, the company sets aside \$1,019,780 for station buildings, grounds and other transportation service improvements; \$56,721 for dock and wharf property, \$191,200 for fuel and water stations; \$241,369 for bridges, trestles and culverts; \$1,222,561 for additional main tracks; \$272,856 for shop build ings, etc.
