Moore yesterday afternoon and re-elected the supervisors for another year, except in supervisory district No. 5, where Miss Goldie Van Bibber handed in her resignation, to take effect June 1. These members are elected for one year only.

The resignation of Miss Goldie Van Bibber was accepted with DR. GULLION WILL sincere regrets. There are already several applicants for her position.
