PARCEL POST

WARNING MADE

Those who attempt to use the parcel post as a collection agency are in danger of prosecution for using the mails with intent to defraud.

A man in Stanwood, Wash., considered that a woman in Portland owed him \$3. He sent her a small package with \$3 C. O. D. charges.

When the woman opened the package she found only a pebble. She asked Postmaster Myers to give her her money back.

Charles Rutherford, district postoffice inspector in charge, at Spokane, construed the regulations to mean that as the Post office Department was concerned, had attempted to use the mails fraudulently.

The woman's money was returned, and the man at Stanwood was "out" the postage and tee C. O. D. charge of 10 cents.

Packages may be sent C. O. D. by parcel post by paying 10 cents more than the regular postage.

Packages on which there is no charge except for postage may also be sent C. O. D., the sender receiving the amount paid for postage and the 10 cent C. O. D. charge after collection has been made from the person to whom the package is addressed.

Thus both the cost of an article sent by parcel post and the postage thereon may be paid by the receiver.
