



#### JAY S. DOUGLAS DIED WEDNESDAY

Jay S. Douglas, died Wednesday morning May 6th, at 7 o'clock. Mr. Douglas was born in Indiana in the year 1825. Later his parants moved to Illinois. In 1853 he came to Oregon For That Carnival and located at Lebanon, where he helped to establish and build the Academy at that place. He entered the ministry with the Methodist church and served as pastor in Washington at Stellacom, Grays Harbor and Cowlitz, and in Oregon at Yamhill, Creswell and Springfield.

He came to Glenada first in 1892 and lived there some-time moving to California and returned to Oregon in 1897 and later took a homestead on the North Fork of Smith river and finally moved from there to Glenada about a year and a half ago.

Since that time he has been in poor health, but maintained good spirits and to the end declared, he was satisfied with what had been his life and was ready to go.

Jay S. Douglas was 81 years and two weeks old when he died, and leaves a devoted wife and one son, Arthur L. Douglas.

The funeral service was conducted Thursday afternoon by Rev John Drumm with intermint in the I. O. O. F. cemetery.
