LARGE INCREASE IN STATE REGISTRATION

Salem, Ore., May 9. (Special to the Register.)—With 10 counties reported unofficially, the registration for the primary election to be held May 15, today totaled 226,924, an increase of 95,044 over the registration for the primary election of 1912, it being 131,880. While the returns from the 10 counties are unofficial in the way that they are statements of totals instead of official abstracts of the votes it is not anticipated that there will be any material variance.

The 10 counties whose statements are unofficial are Baker, Clackamas, Crook, Jackson, Lane, Lincoln, Marion, Multnomah, Washington and Josephine.

Of the total registration reports 134,697 are Republicans, 59,986 are Democrats, 11,177 are Prohibitionists, 6,273 are Socialist, 6,255 are Progressives and 8,536 miscellaneous.
