The School Fair will be held in the school house and will be open during the afternoon of the first day, Thursday, May 21st, from 1 to 4 o'clock, and on the second day, Friday, May, 22d, in the morning from 10 to 12 o'clock, in the afternoon from 1 to 4.

The prizes will be cash. First prize, \$1.00; second prize, 75 cents; third prize, 50 cents; fourth prize 25 cents.

It is suggested that each district hold a cooking contest shortly before Fair time and that the best of these contestants be sent as a representative of that district to the Fair.

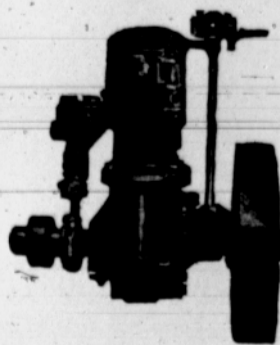
