Buffalo, N. Y., is now trying an automobile wagon for the collection of mail. The mail from forty boxes, covering a territory six miles in length, was collected in less than half the time necessary to cover the same route with a horse and wagon. The experiment will be continued, and if it continues to work satisfactorily it is believed that a number of automobiles will be placed in regular commission in connection with the postal service in that and other cities.



line is to be constructed between Liverpool and Manchester, England, The roadway is A-shaped, with a single track, and the car is a "double decker, 60 feet long, and hangs one-half on each side of the A-shaped trestle. The motive power is electricity, and the car carries four motors weighing three tons each. The cost of construction is estimated at \$50,000 to \$100,000 per mile, but the smaller cost of operation is expected to reduce the total cost below that of the steam railway.
