NEW AND CURIOUS.

Fish With Lungs.

In ordinary fish gills take the place of lungs, and are adapted to breathing in water, but two species of fishes have lately been discovered in Africa and Australia which are possessed of lungs. They form the connecting link in the evolution from fishes to the next order of creatures. The reason that these fishes are provided with lungs is that they are found in streams which dry up entirely in the hot summer season, leaving the fishes in the dry beds of the streams. This Dealers in Fruits, Vegetables period of drought often lasts for six moths of the year, and during all this period the fishes lie quiescent in a kind of sack formed out of the clay of the river bed. The fishes are asleep in their queer earthen houses all this time, but they breathe and are kept alive through their lungs.

When placed in warm water the clay shell opens, as it would naturally in the first heavy rainfall in its native haunts, and the eel-like fish emerges and becomes active at once.

The royal society of Queensland, fearing the extirpation of these queer fish, as so many have been killed by exploding dynamite in their native streams, have planted a number of them in various places so that they are now to be found in many Australian streams. They are certainly the queerest fish in the world.
