The completed photograph accordingly shows a large number of wellmarked dots for stars, and among them one faint line for the asteroid.

Eros is quite a small globe. If the moon were to be crushed into 2,000,000 equal fragments, each of those parts would be as big as Eros.

Eros is the nearest globe to the earth in the wide expanse of heaven. 
