### The Ferment of Science.

The Rev. Dr. N. D. Hillis, of Plymouth Church, Brooklyn, N. Y., from his pulpit, on March 25th, repudiated the foreordination article of the Westminster Confession of Faith, the clause which declares that God has been pleased to pass by the non-elect without making provision for their salvation, and that the number of those for whom he has made provision is so certain and definite that it cannot be either increased or diminished. In the course of his sermon he said:

"I would rather shake my fist in the face of the eternal and fling every vile epithet toward the stainless throne where Eternal Mercy sits with the world's atoning Savior, than lift my hand with that creed toward God's throne and affirm that I taught or believed it."—[Current History.

The unifying, organizing and civilizing work of Science is a ferment which has put out the witch fires, the fires of the Inquisition and the theory of demoniacal possession; it is spewing out the barbarous theories of foreordination, the damnation of unbaptized infants, and the damnation of the endless generations, through ceaseless centuries, because Adam, a newly created creature of the dust, disobeyed the great "I Am," and the crucifixion of an innocent victim to save the unjustly condemned from eternal tortures imposed by the God of "Eternal Mercy."

The mind and heart of Dr. Hillis have been purified of the foreordination, theory, but he yet holds on to an atoning Savior, a superstition as barbarous as foreordination.
