ORTHODOX LAW.

It seems that there is an orthodox legal element, as well as an orthodox religious one in our country, who would kill the heathen to make them understand how we civilized people live up to law and order. Read the following from the Legal Adviser:

It is said that "technically" the civilized powers are not at war with China. So, also, when savages on our territorial borders proceed to slaughter peaceful settlers and battalions of soldiers are sent to shoot the savages to death, it may be said that "technically" we are not at war with them. No declaration of war is issued. No ambassador or other minister receives his passport. The savages are shot, nevertheless. So should it be in the case of these Asiatic savages. They are not entitled to national recognition by the formality of a declaration of war. They have forfeited all claim to any recognition whatever by a civilized power. They are entitled only to the swiftest possible extermination.
