## Arts Resource Team Arts Map and More!

The OCCA (that's two C's) has begun a year long project to gather information on the arts along the Oregon Coast, beginning with a map of art-related businesses, galleries, and organizations that will be distributed through the local Chambers of Commerce, galleries, bookstores and elsewhere, as well as being available by mail. The Oregon Coast Council for the Arts is also organizing workshops on grant writing and taxes and other business skills for artists who live on the edge (in more ways than one).

"This is an exciting opportunity to serve many individual artists and the very active arts business of our counties," says Mike Lainoff, Director of the Small Business Development Center in Lincoln County who, along with his counterparts in Tillamook and Clatsop counties will also be participating in this effort.

Sharon Morgan, Executive Director of the OCCA informs us, "More than just updating information and statistics, this project positions the arts of the region to be first in line for some important new resources." It seems the legislation is currently pending in Salem to identify the arts as one of Oregon's "Key Industries" (who would have guessed?). And it further seems that "Key Industries" are eligible for "significant" funding from the Department of Economic Development (Cool, huh?) (You might be able to, sort of, win the Lottery after all!)

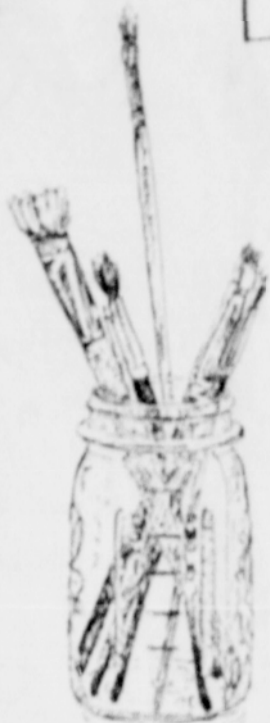

## 4th Annual Community Artist Mini-Courses

Whatever claim Cannon Beach might have as an "Art Colony" must be judged with the Community Artist Mini-Courses being added into the equation. For the last four years local artists have been sharing their talent with the children at Cannon Beach Elementary School. Every year a week's worth of Art Classes are taught by local and regional artists, of all disciplines: Classic Ballet, Improvisational Theatre, Watercolours, Woodworking, Thinking Art, Re-Use Art, Basketmaking, Mexican Crafts, and a host of other subjects, are all offered in the week of March 11th (Thursday) and March 16th (Tuesday).

March 19th there will be a performance open to the public from 1pm to 2pm, and a showing of the children's work from 3:30pm to 7pm, in the Cannon Beach Elementary School Auditorium.

There are a lot of people who live in Cannon Beach, or Portland Eugene, or wherever who say they are artists but when they try to show a child what it is they do, or why they do it, they find themselves feeling like a naked emperor.
