### Arts Resource Team Arts Map and More!

The OCCA (that's two C's) has begun a year long project to gather information on the arts along the Oregon Coast. beginning with a map of art-related businesses, galleries, and organizations that will be distributed through the local Chambers of Commerce, galleries. bookstores and elsewhere, as well as being available by mail. The Oregon Coast Council for the Arts is also organizing workshops on grant writing and taxes and other business skills for artists who live on the edge (in more ways than one).

This is an exciting opportunity to serve many individual artists and the very active arts business of our counties," says Mike Lainoff, Director of the Small Business Development Center in Lincoln County; who, along with his conterparts in Tillamook and Clatsop counties will also be participating in this effort.

Sharon Morgan, Executive Director of the OCCA informs us. More than just updating information and statistics, this project positions the arts of the region to be first in line for some important new resources." It seems the legislation is currently pending in Salem to identify the arts as one of Oregon's "Key Industries" (who would have guessed?). And it further seems that Key Industries" are eligible for significant funding from the Department of Economic Development (Cool, huh?) (You might be able to sort of, win the Lottery after all!)
