#### CHIEF WILMA MANKILLER

One of the most influential women in North America, Chief Wilma Mankiller, appears at Powell's to read from her new autobiography; Mankiller: A Chief and Her People.

Mankiller is the Principle Chief of the Cherokee Nation, a tribe of over 140,000 people, and the first female to lead a major Native American tribe. Her lifelong devotion to the well being of her people has come with a great deal of struggle, most notably her family's government relocation to San Francisco, and the sexism she encountered as her visibilty rose in the tribe.

Since becoming Cherokee Chief,
Mankiller's prominence has become
international, and she has been awarded a
host of honorary degrees and citations,
including Ms. magazine's 1987 Woman of
the Year. Alice Walker has said of
Mankiller, "I recognize in her the greatest
beauty, dignity, and truthfulness. A
radical love of people and an empathy with
the earth."
