

## CAN I WALK, BIKE, OR RIDE THE SHUTTLE INSTEAD?

The Cannon Beach Energy Committee encourages you to develop a new habit.

Often people comment that after they've had a hard time finding a parking place downtown, they remember they could have taken the Shuttle or walked.

The Cannon Beach Energy Committee is providing you with this cut-out to place on the dashboard of your car. Challenge yourself at least once a week in this coming month, to walk or take the Shuttle rather than starting your car.

The Shuttle, which operates on natural gas, began in 1990 in recognition of the need to save energy, help reduce pollution, reduce pressure on the limited parking facilities, and reduce traffic congestion in our area. The Shuttle operates Friday through Tuesday 10am to 1pm and 2pm to 6pm. It has been equipped to meet the specifications of the Americans with Disabilities Act. During the periods the Shuttle is not committed to its schedule of routine runs, it is available to community groups who can provide a qualified driver, and is charged on mileage used.
