WILDLIFE ON THE EDGE

Many seasonal local wild plants are edible, and even palatable. Along the road-sides, in damp woody areas, or in the backyard are scattered a wonderful assortment of nutritious and beautiful greenery. It could be very pleasant used as a **SPRING SALAD**... of course, well-inspected for tiny bugs, miniature slugs and other potential fresh meat.

Miner's Lettuce and Candyflower are closely related; both are juicy and pulpy. Miner's Lettuce has a peppery flavor.

Wood Sorrel has a wonderful tart lemony taste, and contributes much of the flavor, especially if used generously.

The tightly-curved tips of some Ferns can add an interesting flavor to the mix. However, this can be somewhat risky because some ferns are known to be carcinogenic.

Candyflower is a bit bland and watery, but its pink and white flowers look very pretty with the green.

The scent of wild Violets is very subtle and delicate, and the purple-blue blossoms add another splash of colour.

Dandelions are too much maligned. They are chock full of vitamins and other good things and can also be cooked like spinach. Also they are very plentiful.
