## MEETING HIGHLIGHTS CITY COUNCIL MAY 3

- Adopted Ordinance 94-08, amending the zoning code to establish an Oceanfront Management Overlay zone. Major changes effected by the ordinance from the present requirements are:
  - Adopted a map which defines the location of active dunes.
  - Requires a development permit (with a building permit) for a variety of activities that occur on the oceanfront.
  - Establishes standards for remedial grading of dune areas when necessary to protect a dwelling or structure from sand/mudrunoff caused by wind-borne sand.
  - Establishes new standards for dune stabilization programs.
  - Establishes new standards for the trimming of dune grass.
- Requires that a development permit be obtained prior to construction of beach access stairs.
- Clarifies how the oceanfront setback is calculated.
- Incorporates a map of active dunes and the report "Delineation of Active Dunes and Conditionally Stabilized Dunes in Cannon Beach, May 1993" into the Comprehensive Plan Background Report.
- Ordinance 94-08 becomes effective on June 2, 1994. Questions should be addressed to Rammar Bart, City Planner, (503)436-2045.
